

Michigan Envirothon State Competition Volunteer Opportunities

Registration/Information (3 positions per shift / Shift available all 3 days)

- Help teams & volunteers check-in for the event; provide general information to event participants; assist with other tasks as needed. **Team Advisors welcome!**

Project Monitor (1 position per shift/ Shifts available first and second day)

- Help with traffic flow for the Community Outreach Project Presentations; locate & prepare teams who are “on-deck” for their presentation; assist judges as needed. **Team Advisors welcome!**

Project Timer (1 position per shift/ Shifts available first and second day)

- Assure teams and judges are following proper timing and procedure for COP presentations, keep time for Community Outreach Project Presentations; assist judges as needed.

Audio-Visual Coordinator (1 position per shift/ Shifts available all 3 days)

- Assist teams and other presenters with audio/visual needs; assist in other areas as needed. **Team Advisors welcome!**

Station Leaders (4 – 6 positions per shift/ Shifts available second and third day)

- Administer tests to teams at one of several outdoor testing sites; help teams locate site-specific questions/species/etc.; help with set-up and tear-down of station.

Group Leaders (4 – 6 positions per shift/ Shifts available second and third day)

- Escort teams to and from testing stations; help teams locate site-specific questions/species/etc.; assist Station Leaders as needed. **Team Advisors welcome!**

Test Runner (1-2 positions per shift/ Shifts available second and third day)

- Collect completed tests from testing sites and deliver them to the scoring room; assist Station Leaders and Scoring Room as needed. *requires transportation between testing sites and scoring room

Scoring Room Assistant (4 – 8 positions per shift/ Shifts available every day)

- Testing packet and station leader set up; all testing / awards set up as needed
- Grade tests, help enter testing scores into the scoring database; assist in other tasks/areas as needed.

Recreation Coordinator (1 – 3 positions per shift / Shifts available first and second evening)

- Help coordinate recreational activities for students to participate in during “down time”; direct students to various activities available to them; assist in other areas as needed.
- Some assistance prior to the event may be needed. **Team Advisors welcome!**

Photographer and Videographer (1 – 3 positions per shift/ Shifts available every day)

- Photograph and or Video various aspects of the event; assist in other areas as needed.
- This activity will take place throughout the event; photographers/ videographers will need to make arrangements with the Envirothon Coordinator for submitting their photos/ video
- Personal equipment welcome, coordination and instruction prior to event may be necessary. **Team Advisors welcome!**
