

MAEAP CONSERVATION TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE INITIATIVE
POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT:

The Michigan Agriculture Environmental Assurance Program Conservation Technical Assistance Initiative (CTAI) is seeking interested applicants to serve as a CTAI Engineer in the Jackson County Conservation District. The applicant must possess a Bachelor of Science Degree in Environmental Engineering, Civil Engineering, or Agricultural Engineering. Experience in AutoCAD, surveying, and/or construction is desired, but not a requirement. Successful completion of the Fundamentals of Engineering exam is also desired. The position will be located in Jackson, Michigan. The selected individual will handle assignments in a multi-county area. The work will be performed under the approval of the Natural Resources Conservation Service.

The engineer will be responsible to work with individuals in the agricultural community to conduct field investigations, complete topographic and bench-level surveys with a total station and survey grade GPS equipment, prepare engineering designs, and oversee construction on a variety of agricultural practices. These practices may include agrichemical containment facilities, livestock, watering facilities, grade stabilization structures, grassed waterways, sedimentation control basins and wetland restoration projects. The individual will gain substantial hands-on field and design experience and will be expected to work in adverse weather conditions

Entry level pay will be \$22.50/hour. Benefit packages are available. Interested applicants must submit a resume, official transcripts, and a cover letter indicating relevant experience no later than June 1, 2018.
