FORESTER POSITION ANNOUNCEMENT

The Delta Conservation District, a local unit of government, is seeking interested applicants for a permanent forester position in the south-central Upper Peninsula. The applicant must possess a minimum of a Bachelor of Science Degree in forestry from an accredited university. Work will be performed under the technical guidance of the senior forester.

The forester position will be mostly field based focusing on education and technical assistance to private landowners. The position will also have responsibility to assist private landowners in implementing a variety of forestland practices that are funded under the USDA Farm Bill.

Starting salary range will be determined upon on education and experience, and is fully supported by the conservation district (this is not a grant funded position). Chosen individual must pass a criminal history check, drug screen and posses a valid Michigan driver's license. Interested applicants must submit a resume, official transcripts, and cover letter indicating relevant experience no later than close of business on Friday September 6th, 2019 to the Delta Conservation District, Attn.
